Law firm provides food, funds for Boca Helping Hands

The law firm of Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs LLP stepped into the holiday spirit by raising money and gathering food for Boca Helping Hands.

The company held an internal competition and, in the end, collected more than 1,200 pounds of food and more than \$600 in cash.

Boca Helping Hands is a nonprofit organization that offers help to the underprivileged. It opened as a food center in November 1998, serving nutritious, hot lunches three days a week and giving out bags of groceries to families. An after-school-sandwich program started in March 1999.

Today, the organization offers five after-school programs for low-income children during the school year, making and delivering more than 60,000 sandwiches

annually.
